



Lemongrass Lantern and Torch Oil

Description

This product is for use only as an outdoor lantern & torch oil.
Follow the instruction of the lantern & torch manufacturers where possible.
Do not overfill Lanterns and Torches.

Directions

1. Remove bottle top and carefully pour into the reservoir.
2. After use, replace cap securely and store in a safe place away from sources of ignition.
3. Allow 10-15 minutes for wick to absorb oil before lighting. After lighting observe flame. A flame that is too high will cause unnecessary smoking. To alleviate this lower the wick. It is essential the wick is kept trimmed.
